At this time the Board will hear any concerns of the citizens in attendance. **The Board may not take any formal action** on matters brought to its attention in this matter. The Board policy requires that those who have complaints on the action or lack of action by its employees take such complaints through the staff and the administration. If this does not resolve the complaint, a Board hearing will be scheduled.

The amount of time allotted for the hearing of the public shall be limited to fifteen minutes per agenda item. The fifteen minute period of time will be divided equally among those wishing to be heard on any one particular agenda item.
